

Lance Won't Be the Only One Wearing the Yellow Jersey! Sizing Samples Available at the February Club Meeting by Tom Eggers

Remember how great Lance looked wearing the Tour's yellow jersey? For 2002/3, you can also look (kinda) like Lance. EBC cycling wear for 2002/3 will feature the same great graphic design as last year, but the apparel's base color will be "pantone yellow". Additionally, we're going to three color (vs. four color) graphics for 2002/3. These changes are in response to the many members who asked that our apparel retain its basic design but be lighter in color, thus easier to see. To view an *approximation* of the new color scheme, go to the EBC web-site at www.elmhurstbicycling.org The image on the web-site does not look *exactly* like the finished product, as moving to three color graphics means the colors within our design will change slightly. The image on the web-site *will* give you an idea of how great the yellow color goes with our graphics. We'll share more information as soon as we and our supplier, Voler Team Apparel, finalize the graphic's colors.

Voler considers a color change to be a new design, so we've lost our volume discount carry-over from 2001. The three color design reduces that increase, however. All apparel is priced at the minimum order size of 25 items per group (total order per group must be 25 or more items for that group's order to be processed):

- •Group 1: Short sleeve and sleeveless jerseys; sleeveless wind shell vest
- •Group 2: Shorts
- •Group 3: Long sleeve items, including jerseys, wind jackets and thermal jackets

If we receive orders for 50 or more items in any group, members purchasing items in that group will get a volume rebate (see order form on Page 6 for details). So your costs could be less than in 2001! EBC 2002/3 cycling wear includes:

- Jerseys available in men's "club" (roomy) and women's sizes. Short (cut-in) sleeve, sleeveless and long sleeve. All have 20" hidden zippers. Material is ProSensor, a moisture transfer fabric with a soft and comfortable feel. EBC graphics/three color designs are sublimated into the fabric (and are, therefore, more permanent than silk screening)

- Team Shorts available in men's and women's sizes. Feature eight panels, anatomical cut, woven leg hem gripper and clean hemmed elastic waste with our sublimated three color design in the side panels. Cantara pad for men, Monolith pad for women (unless preference specified by the member)

Starting Point	Directions
Community Bank of Elmhurst Elmhurst, IL	330 West Butterfield Road, at the intersection of Butterfield Road and Spring Road. The Community Bank is on the southwest corner. Meeting room is on the second floor. Please don't bring bikes into the meeting room.
Depot Elmhurst, IL	Rides start from the public parking lot just east of York Road on Vallette Street. Vallette St. is ¼ mile south of St. Charles Road, York Road is 1 mile west of I-290.
Gazebo Glen Ellyn, IL	On the Prairie Path between Park Ave and Main Street. By car, take Roosevelt Road (Route 38) or North Ave. (Route 64) to Main Street Glen Ellyn (about 1¼ miles west of I-355) and head into downtown Glen Ellyn. The Gazebo is in the middle of the train station parking lot on the south side of the UP tracks.
Busse Woods Elk Grove Village, IL	Take I-290 (Route 53, I-355) to Biesterfield Road East. Beisner Road is the 1 st light East of I-290. Turn North (left) on Beisner Road. Busse Woods entrance is approximately 2 blocks on the left. Ride starts in the first parking lot from the entrance.
Spring Rock Park Western Springs, IL	Spring Rock Park is located at 47 th Street and Central, just East of I-294 (Tri-State Tollway). The parking lot entrance is off Central north of 47th Street.
Villa Park Depot, Villa Park, IL	The Villa Park Depot is located at the intersection of Villa Ave. & Park Ave. on the IPP. Approximately 2-3 blocks South of the Villa Ave. & St. Charles Road intersection in Villa Park.
Volunteer Park Wheaton, IL	Milepost zero on the Prairie Path Main Stem., at the intersection of Liberty and Carlton Streets in Wheaton. ¼ mile north of Roosevelt Road, ½ mile west of Main Street / Schmale Road.
Puffer School Downers Grove, IL	Puffer School is on Belmont Avenue at Prairie Ave., about ½ mile south of Ogden Avenue.
Big Apple Bagels Elmhurst, IL	Big Apple Bagels is located at the corner of York Street and Schiller Ave. in downtown Elmhurst. Schiller is about ¼ mile south of North Ave. (Route 64) and York Street is about 1 mile west of Interstate 290. Note that York Street is one way going North through downtown.

Now that the weather is getting a little colder, only the real *hard-cores* are out riding. Don't be afraid of *snowmines* (an object hidden by snow). Remember, it's a lot harder to take a *soil sample* if the ground is frozen!

Lesson #2:

- •Betty (EBC use only, but could catch on world-wide)- to run over an animal while riding. "Did you see Lou? She really bettied that squirrel as we came 'round the last turn!" Universal usage- any female rider.
- Dialed in- when your bike is set up nicely and everything is working well. Everyone should try to keep their bikes "dialed"
- Gravity check- to fall
- Schwag- bike stuff given away at trade shows, during promotions etc.
- Sitting in- to be lazy and never take the lead when, for example, riding into a headwind with a group
- Velo-porn- great looking bike stuff advertised in catalogues, magazines etc. May lead to *checkus bouncus mortis* (a common, sometimes fatal disease during the off-season)
- Wrench- a bike mechanic, or someone who is good at fixing bikes ("That Ted! What a wrench!")

Time to put those holiday *giblets* (neat little add-ons, usually lightweight and very expensive) on your bike, bundle up and ride!
