SALT CREEK TRAIL: ELMHURST SEGMENT UNDER CONSTRUCTION

The Salt Creek Trail, a regional trail, involves the Elmhurst Park District and seven other local agencies in a 13 year effort to complete the 30.6 mile-long trail. Extending from the Busse Woods Forest Preserve in NW Cook County, through NE DuPage County to the Chicago Portage National Historic Site at 47th and Harlem, the Salt Creek Trail provides access to forest preserves, local parks, Brookfield Zoo, historic sites, and Oakbrook Center, among other sites.

Construction of Elmhurst's portion of the trail is currently underway as contractors and surveyors have begun staking out the trail, removing trees, installing silt fences, and constructing trail bridges. Once construction begins, the existing wood chip from Madison

SALT CREEK TRAIL

Street south to Eldridge Park will be closed. The majority is to take place this spring with completion scheduled for this Summer.

The new asphalt trail begins in Elmhurst at the intersection of Thomas Street and Monterrey Avenue, north of St. Charles Road. It then proceeds south to link up with Illinois Prairie Path bridge over Route 83 and continues east along Prairie Path Lane to Fairview Avenue where it turns south. The trail follows Fairview Avenue to Madison Street where it will link up with, and take the place of, the EPD's existing wood chip trail to Eldridge Park. The trail then continues through Eldridge Park, crosses Butterfield Road and continues south behind the Astoria Place Townhomes to Oak

Brook.

The cost of the EPD's portion of the is \$2,700,000, of which \$500,000 is funded by the EPD and the balance from state and federal grants.

If you just want to help cleanup - head out to the trails that day and carefully

pickup litter along the trail. Take your filled garbage bags to the nearest trash container.

It is recommended that all volunteers wear gloves, long sleeve shirts and long pants to help eliminate scrapes and cuts from thorny bushes or sharp objects left as trash along the trails. Those with wagons or two wheel carts to help carry the filled garbage bags are asked to bring them along too.

Community Bank of Elmhurst Elmhurst, IL	330 West Butterfield Road, at the intersection of Butterfield Road and Spring Road. The Community Bank is on the southwest corner. Meeting room is on the second floor. Please donAft bring bikes into the meeting room.
Depot, Elmhurst, IL	Rides start from the public parking lot just east of York Road on Vallette Street. Vallette St. is 1/4 mile south of St. Charles Road, York Road is 1 mile west of I-290.
Depot, Villa Park, IL	The Villa Park Depot is located at the intersection of Villa Ave. & Park Ave. on the IPP. Approximately 2-3 blocks South of the Villa Ave. & St. Charles Road intersection in Villa Park.
Gazebo, Glen Ellyn, IL	On the Prairie Path between Park Ave and Main Street. By car, take Roosevelt Road (Route 38) or North Ave. (Route 64) to Main Street Glen Ellyn (about 11/4 miles west of I-355) and head into downtown Glen Ellyn. The Gazebo is in the middle of the train station parking lot on the south side of the UP tracks.
IMAX Theatre Woodridge, IL	Located on Rt. 53, one half mile north of Hobson Road, one half mile south of Maple Ave. Riders meet in the parking lot in front of the theatre.
McCollum Park, Downers Grove, IL	McCollum Park is located at the SE Corner of 67th and Main Streets in Downers Grove.
