NEW GLARUS WEEKEND 2008

This year's New Glarus, Wisconsin weekend trip is scheduled for September 12, 13 and 14 2008. This is a joint venture between the EBC and the Naperville Bicycle Club. As of press time we had 6 rides scheduled, with the following led by Lee Nye:

- Friday 9/12 at 1:00 pm, a ride either to Blanchardville or Evansville.
- Saturday 9/13 at 8:00 am a longer ride to Mt. Horeb and beyond.
- Sunday 9/14 at TBD am, a shorter ride, leaving for home in the early afternoon.

The following are being led by Larry Gitchell:

- Friday 9/12 at 1:00 pm, a 30-35 mile ride to either Bellville or Mount Vernon.
- Saturday 9/13 at 8:00 am a 55-60 mile ride to the Earth Rider Bike shop in Brodhead.
- Sunday 9/14 at TBD am, a 36-40 mile ride to Baumgartner's in Monroe.

Three trail rides had been proposed but not yet scheduled:

- Friday 9/12 at 3 PM Sugar River Trail south towards Albany 20 mile.
- Saturday 9/13 at 9 AM Badger State Trail north towards Madison *** 30 mile.

 Sunday 9/14 at 7 AM - Badger State Trail south towards Monroe - 25 miles

*** The Saturday ride will go through the Stewart Tunnel, lights required

All rides start at the Chalet Landhaus parking lot except where otherwise noted. Check the schedule on the EBC web page for late updates.

10 rooms were at the Chalet Landhaus (\$110 per night for two persons, \$140 if you only stay Saturday night), which includes a buffet breakfast on Saturday and Sunday mornings. The Chalet has an indoor pool, whirlpool, sauna, and steam room. Go to: www.chaletlandhaus.com for more information. The Chalet fills up most weekends so it may be hard to get a room at the last minute. They tend to give the rooms away if they are not reserved with a credit card so make your reservations as soon as possible to be sure you will get a room. This past Sunday it came to me that I've not thanked all those who pitched in to continue the Sunday morning ride in my absence. To all those terrific leaders—Thank YOU.


I would also like to remind members to patronize our sponsors. These are the merchants that have made possible our continued success without the need for either a fund raiser or major ride event to fill our treasury.

ADVOCACY UPDATE

It has been a busy month for the Advocacy Committee. Though not directly an Advocacy event, the Elmhurst Green Fest was well attended by residents (estimated at over 2,500) and well served by EBC volunteers (16 members). It provided a great opportunity to tell the public about the Club and to share information about safe biking practices. With a little effort we will rally the membership for a showing again next year.

Since the last newsletter we have had some great activity with the Elmhurst City Council. We presented at the Public Affairs and Safety (PAS) Committee with 17 cyclists in attendance (mostly from our club). This was a great show of support from the Club and nearly required a change of meeting rooms in order to accommodate us all. In addition to the three alderman who sit on the committee (Mulliner, Bram and Nybo), Mayor Marcucci joined us. We carried the message that biking is becoming a stronger element in our community which needs to be accommodated and not ignored. Strong supporting statements were delivered by all our elected officials for the need to address safe biking in

On Aug. 20 the Advocacy Committee met to develop a "short" list of easily implemented ideas that can have a visible impact on biking in Elmhurst. This was done at the suggestion of Alderman Mark Mulliner and includes bike racks in the central business district, suggested routes through and into Elmhurst, better Prairie Path crosswalks, and bicyclist and car driver education. These will be taken to the next PAS committee meeting on Aug. 25 and, hopefully, forwarded to the Elmhurst City Council for action.

Elmhurst.

Those at the last meeting got to see the most recent iteration of the DuPage County Bikeway Plan Map. This has just been issued by the office of Deborah Fagan, County Trail Coordinator, and outlines the long range plan for trails in the county. DuPage County is doing a great job for bicyclists. A copy will be available online soon. You can get a printed copy by emailing Deborah at Deborah.Fagan@dupageco.org. The County is working on a users' map specifically for bicyclists and expects to have copies within the next month. The Club will be sent a copy for every member so look for that at one of the Fall meetings. These will be available at a regular meeting only and will not be mailed out.

Finally, for those who were not at the last Club meeting, Sam Gunda brought us news from the Village of Addison that funding for the north leg of the Salt Creek Greenway Trail has made the first cut (of 2). The final selections will be made in early September based on public comment.

THE SECOND ANNUAL "I&M CANAL WALK OR RIDE"



Grab your walking shoes. Or get out your bike. And join the fun at the second annual I&M Canal Walk or Ride on Saturday, September 13, 2008.

The I&M Canal Walk or Ride is a special event organized by the nonprofit Canal Corridor Association to raise funds to enhance the trails and other attractions in the I&M Canal National Heritage Corridor. The event is generously underwritten by Hayes Mechanical.

"This is a great way to showcase the scenery and charm of the I&M Canal while raising funds for a good cause," said Ana Koval, president and CEO of Canal Corridor Association. "It's also a chance to meet and greet your friends and neighbors while enjoying the outdoors on a fall morning."

The non-competitive Walk or Ride begins at 8 am and ends at noon in Canalport Park, Morris, Illinois. Choose from a 1- to 5-mile walk or a 10- to 25-mile bike ride. Walkers will head west on the I&M Canal State Trail; bicyclists will ride east. All will meet back at the park to celebrate afterwards with music and refreshments. Prizes will be awarded for the largest teams and the biggest fundraisers.

It's easy to join the fun. Just go to the Canal Corridor Association website, http://www.canalcor.org, to sign up and pledge. Registration is \$20 per person for adults and \$10 per person for children under 12. Why not invite your friends, family and colleagues and form a team? You and your teammates can take care of everything online.

Volunteers are welcome, too. You can help with setup the day before the event and/or with a variety of day-of-event activities, including registration, distributing water on the trail to walkers and riders, goodie bag distribution and more.

Past the cemetery, turn left east bound onto 95th Street. Take the next right onto Wolf Road and into Palos. Bullfrog is the first Grove on your right.
Depot, Elmhurst, IL	Rides start from the public parking lot just east of York Road on Vallette Street. Vallette St. is 1/4 mile south of St. Charles Road, York Road is 1 mile west of I-290.
Depot, Villa Park, IL	The Villa Park Depot is located at the intersection of Villa Ave. & Park Ave. on the IPP. Approximately 2-3 blocks South of the Villa Ave. & St. Charles Road intersection in Villa Park.
Gazebo, Glen Ellyn, IL	On the Prairie Path between Park Ave and Main Street. The Gazebo is in the middle of the train station parking lot on the south side of the UP tracks.
IMAX Theatre Woo- dridge, IL	Located on Rt. 53, one half mile north of Hobson Road, one half mile south of Maple Ave. Riders meet in the parking lot in front of the theatre.
