Fight For Air Ride - June, 2016 by Linnea Myers

As many of you know, several members of the Elmhurst Bicycle Club participated in the three-day, 150-mile American Lung Association Fight for Air Ride on June 10-12, 2016, from Crystal Lake, IL, to The Abbey Resort in Lake Geneva, WI. We rode approximately 50 miles each day in heat and wind and up and down the hills of Wisconsin. The Ride is always lots of fun for a very worthy cause.

This was the fourth year that EBC participated in this charity ride as a team. Our EBC Team did an outstanding job this year and raised \$17,691.15 for the American Lung Association, which put us in 3rd place for the 2016 Top Fundraising Team Challenge. We were #3 out of 18 teams! Four members of our EBC Team made the list of top 10 individual fundraisers out of 118 riders. Those 118 riders raised a total of \$160,000.00 for the American Lung Association!



Illinois Cornfields Gravel Grinder Metric Century October 2, 2016 by Pravin Patel

Editor's note: A couple of years ago "Gravel Grinder" was not part of the club lexicon. But EBCers have more recently started to tackle these rides. Pravin's ride description begins to define a Gravel Grinder: "We will ride a gravel grinder metric century in central Illinois. Our route comprises of rural agricultural country roads laid with lightly compacted loose gravel. A cross bike, a fat-tire bike or a MTB would be appropriate for the undulating terrain and riding conditions. Please, bring food, sandwiches/energy bars etc, and water for the full ride as there are no gas stations or other facilities available along the route. Riders are expected to be self-sufficient and well conditioned for this ride. There are no bailouts, however, I will provide cue sheets for an alternate route of 48 miles. If a rider wishes to cut short the ride after riding 30 miles, he/she is expected to get back on his/her own. We will ride as a group, taking breaks as necessary."

And here is Pravin's report: "Above is the Garmin map data for the gravel grinder Metric Century ride. Three of us, Tom Preston, Karen Kiley and I, rode gravel roads of central Illinois for 64 miles. The terrain was rolling and 'roads' were almost devoid of cars. Few roads had signs and some were just access roads used by local farmers. We saw grain silos, harvesters and tractors with huge wheels. We saw some friendly dogs who would follow us for a minute or two. But, there was one aggressive one, who would not let up until we sped up to 18-20 mph to drop him! We carried snacks and water we needed as none were available along the route. We rode our mountain bikes with a bit narrower tires (40 mm front and 33 mm rear) which had less aggressive treads. Still, we found the going harder. It is surprising to find such riding within an hour's drive from Elmhurst. I wish to find more gravel roads next year."

Proposed Amendment to the Illinois Constitution by Chuck Dean

Just a reminder to EBC voters: you will have an opportunity to vote yes or no to an amendment to the Illinois Constitution. As seen on sample ballots, this amendment uses the following words: Yes or No, For the proposed addition of Section 11 to Article IX of the Illinois Constitution.

Section 11 deals with "Transportation Funds." The term "Transportation Funds" includes funds that can be spent on bicycling infrastructure. Make yourself an informed voter.




